WHAT TO DO THIS JUNE IN YOUR GARDEN

- Apply fresh mulch to your garden beds. This helps keep weeds down it will also keep the roots shaded on your shrubs, trees and perennials and will reduce the water the plants will require.
- Dead head annuals and pinch back late summer flowering perennials.
- Fertilize shrubs, trees, and conifers.
- Keep on top of your weeding so they do not get out of control.
- Trim hedges.
- Fertilize your lawn with a slow release nitrogen fertilizer such as Marigolds own blend 26-7-14.
- Plant up your containers. Vegetables, herbs, annuals, shrubs, and trees can all be grown successfully in pots.
- Keep a watchful eye on your plants for any signs of pests or diseases. They are much easier taken care of in the early stages.
